






FIRST at a Glance

Charge Conference Minutes from November 6, 2016

Randy Cross, District Superintendent, opened with a prayer.

Pastor Sara reported on things we can celebrate, which are examples that God is breaking through!

- In 2016 we have an average of 339 people worshipping on the weekends! (The average was 286 people in 2011 and 218 people in 2010.)
- FUMC has grown by 121 people!
- There have been 21 baptisms!
- We have welcomed 44 new members!
- There are an average of 63 children and 34 youth attending weekly Wednesday programming!
- Since September 2016 we have seen 122 different kids and 62 different youth!
- We have fed and clothed over 1000 people through Tuesday Morning Breakfast, the Free Sale and Food Giveaway!

Tim Riley and Ed Togel provided an update on our MCCI prescriptions.

- Leadership & Staff: Leadership Team was formed and began meeting in July 2016. Staff positions have been re-aligned as of October 2016. Identifying and filling needs of future staff was complete in January 2016.
- Launch Seminar & Catalog was completed in 2016. The Leadership Development component will be starting in 2017.
- Communication: The website, bulletin, newsletter and email were revised and completed in October 2016. The Guest Welcome process was completed in October 2016. The Sound System upgrades are in progress and are projected to be completed by Easter. There have been two series of triad events held. The community connection assessment was also completed.
- Facility Focus: This will be worked on in 2017.
- Signature Ministry: A focus on single parent families was identified. Planning is in process to shape the ministry for implementation in 2017.

Ed Togel provided an update on the Stewardship Campaign.

- To date, 131 estimated giving cards have been received for a total income of \$329,944.
- There are 115 estimated giving cards that have not been returned, for an estimated \$137,226 additional income.
- We anticipate receiving \$8700 in loose plate offerings, and \$85,300 in sponsorships.
- Total income is projected to be \$561,170.

Ryan Wilson, on behalf of the Leadership Team, made a motion to increase Pastor Sara's compensation for the upcoming year. The salary is currently at \$61,346 and was approved to move to \$66,127 for the upcoming year.

Pastor Sara shared three goals for 2017.

- Outreach & Signature Ministries because 70% of people in Watertown that do not have a church home.
- Facility Focus
- Growing Discipleship, including implementing a discipleship pathway and First Church Leadership Academy.

Pastor Randy prayed for FUMC and our 2017 goals.

Pastor Randy answered questions from the membership and confirmation students.

Pastor Sara provided the closing prayer.
